



# GREENE SCHOLARS PROGRAM

## EXPECTED OUTCOMES AND COMMITMENT

2018-2019 Academic Year

It is the philosophy of the Greene Scholars Program (GSP) not to leave any student behind in our quest to significantly improve the success of African-American students in the areas of math and science in San Francisco Bay Area and the surrounding communities. Therefore, we strive for a 100% success rate in achieving our stated goals, which are listed below. We are committed to bringing to bear as many resources in the school districts and communities as possible, in order to achieve these goals. However, we recognize that families will relocate and/or choose not to take advantage of the resources we offer, or that unforeseen difficulties may arise. Consequently, although we strive for 100% of GSP scholars to achieve our stated goals, we anticipate that at least 80% of GSP scholars will attain them.

1. 100% of the Greene Scholars will earn grades of B or better (or equivalent) in math and science during the Fall and Spring report card period.
2. 100% of the Greene Scholars in grades 3 - 12 will compete in our January Science Fair.
3. 100% of our Greene Scholars in grades 6 - 12 will participate in the National Society of Black Engineers Pre-College Initiative.
4. At least one parent from each GSP family will actively participate in each scheduled Parent meeting, or send a representative to do so.
5. At least one parent from each GSP family will actively participate in supporting one or more activities of the GSP.
6. 100% of the Greene Scholars will complete skill-appropriate technical training.
7. 100% of the Greene Scholars will actively participate in meetings designed for them.
8. 100% of the Greene Scholars will maintain Grade Point Averages (GPAs) of B or better (or equivalent).
9. 100% of the Greene Scholars will participate in at least one academic enrichment program during the August-May school year.
10. 100% of the families in the GSP will donate (or solicit) \$450 to help support the program.
11. 100% of the families in the GSP will solicit or contribute \$100 of advertisements for the annual souvenir booklet or participate in campaigns to support the program.
12. 100% of the families in the GSP will commit to volunteer a minimum of 40 hours per year to their assigned committees.

We commit to strive to attain these goals, realizing that they are designed to help achieve the mission of the Greene Scholars Program. We recognize that circumstances may hinder our ability to meet these goals and, therefore, pledge to notify the GSP's Executive Director in a timely fashion when we are finding it difficult to meet them. We understand that consistently missing these benchmarks will result in consultation with the GSP Executive Director and possible removal from the program.
